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General Advice

- 1. Adequate rest.
- 2. Avoid cold and refrigerated foods
- 3. Avoid AC environment and blowing wind

 - 4. Have a lot of fluids to keep yourself hydrated. Don't only drink plain water, but also include tender coconut water, vegetable soup and fresh fruit juices (with no added sugar).

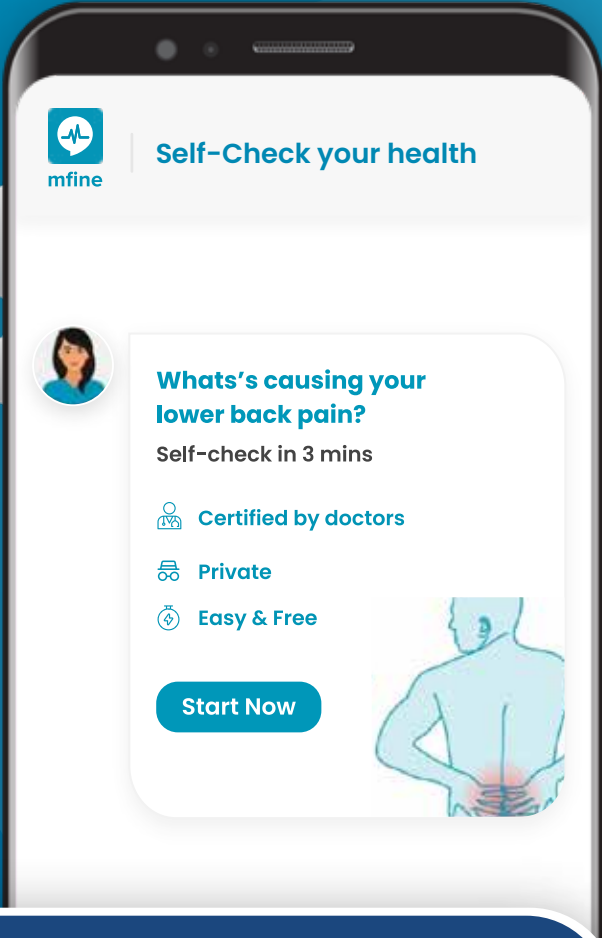
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
